

Directions to the Show

From Belfast: A6 Glenshane Road approaching the City, take the third exit at Altnagelvin roundabout (immediately after Hospital). Go straight through two roundabouts on Crescent Link (A514), at third roundabout (Caw roundabout), take the first exit onto the A2, Clooney Road. Travel along Clooney Road, which becomes Limavady Road. Entrance to Foyle Arena, St Columb's Park, will be on the right, just prior to pedestrian crossing.

From Omagh: A5 approaching the City at Waterside end of Craigavon Bridge, continue to follow A5 towards Coleraine. Go straight through one roundabout (at train station) and move into the left lane. Stay in left lane around next roundabout and filter left at traffic lights towards Limavady / Coleraine. Travel along Limavady Road and entrance to Foyle Arena, St Columb's Park will be on the left, just after pedestrian crossing.

From Coleraine: Follow A2 approaching the City. At Caw roundabout take the second exit onto Clooney Road. Travel along Clooney Road, which becomes Limavady Road. Entrance to Foyle Arena, St Columb's Park, will be on the right, just prior to pedestrian crossing.

From Donegal – via Craigavon Bridge (old bridge): Cross Craigavon Bridge to the Waterside and turn left, joining A5 towards Coleraine. Go straight through one roundabout (at train station) and move into the left lane. Stay in left lane around next roundabout and filter left at traffic lights towards Limavady / Coleraine. Travel along Limavady Road and entrance to Foyle Arena, St Columb's Park will be on the left, just after pedestrian crossing.

From Donegal – via Foyle Bridge (new bridge): Cross Foyle Bridge to the Waterside (moving into right land prior to roundabout), and at the Caw roundabout take the third exit onto Clooney Road. Travel along Clooney Road, which becomes Limavady Road. Entrance to Foyle Arena, St Columb's Park, will be on the right, just prior to pedestrian crossing.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. (13th May 2017). Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value. A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety Classes unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a Breed class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions from this Regulation are:- From 1st January 2017, and for a period of one year the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class have been suspended.

- (1) A puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed;
- (2) A dog in Any Variety Field Trial or Working Trial Class;
- (3) A dog in Any Variety Veteran Class;
- (4) A dog in Any Variety Champion Class;
- (5) As provided in Kennel Club Definitions of Classes;
- (6) A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge;
- (7) A dog in Good Citizen Scheme Classes;
- (8) Exhibits bred by the scheduled breed Judge.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- (1) **Withdrawal:** The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.
- (2) **Transfer:**
 - a. If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - b. For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty-four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - c. For any reason, other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - d. If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

PUPPY For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

NOVICE For dogs, which have not won a Challenge Certificate or 3 or more first prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy, Special Puppy classes excepted whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled.

Brace For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

SPECIAL YEARLING For dogs of six and not exceeding 24 months of age on the first day of the Show.

IMPORTED REGISTER For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever.

STEWARDS: All aspiring judges need to have stewarding experience.

For club members, if you have ambitions to judge at our Show in the future, it is a Club Rule that you must have stewarded at our Show on at least one occasion.

If you would like to steward at our show, please contact the Secretary.

14. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
15. It is not acceptable to handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. Exhibitors should note that such practices could constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
16. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
17. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
18. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS:** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
 - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight.
 - There should be plenty of free-flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

19. Not for Competition entries not accepted.
20. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.

Rules and Regulations

1. The show will open at 8.45 am.
2. Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. Judging will commence at 9.30 am.
4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
6. Entry Fees: Enter 3 or more dogs in any class except Stakes: £12.00
First entry includes catalogue: £8.00
Subsequent entries, except Stakes classes: £2.00
Stakes classes: £2.00
Junior Handling classes: £1.00
AV Brace & AV New Exhibit: NO CHARGE
7. PUPPY STAKES: Best Puppy in Stakes - £10.00 Reserve Best Puppy in Stakes - £5.00
VETERAN STAKES: Best Veteran in Stakes - £10.00 Reserve Best Veteran in Stakes - £5.00
CHAMPION STAKES: Best Champion in Stakes - £10.00 Reserve Champion in Stakes - £5.00
8. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
9. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
11. A Special Best Puppy will be awarded from Best Puppy in Stakes.
12. **Best in Show:** From 1st January 2017, and for a period of one year the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.
 - a. **Best of Breed:** Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.

Best of Group and subsequent placings must be selected from:- a) The Best of Breed winners in each group provided that they are unbeaten winning dogs. b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection for Best in Show.

 - b. *Withdrawal from other Competition:* Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show maybe withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best in Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from AV Classes when judged before Breed Classes.
 - c. *Proviso:* For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

INTRODUCTION TO JUDGES

MS JACKIE THOMSON (JANTAVIA) (BIS)

Jackie, from Scotland, starting handling in her early years, beginning with her mother's German Shepherd Dogs. Her interest in the Rottweiler began in 1983, and later she introduced Akitas to her Kennel. Amongst the awards she has achieved with her dogs are UK Champions, CCs, RCCs, Junior Warrants and Green Stars.

Jackie has served on Committees, holding posts as Vice Chair (2010-11), Secretary of Scottish

Rottweiler Club (current), has served as Treasurer, and a Committee member of the Working & Pastoral Breeds of Scotland.

Jackie has awarded CCs at Drifffield Agricultural Society and SKC.

MISS SARAH CROSS (DERSIEGER)

Sarah, from Scotland, has owned Rottweilers since 1998, actively showing since 2006. In 2010, Sarah added French Bulldogs to her show team and has been successful in both breeds and amongst her awards are Stud Book Numbers, CCs, RCCs, Junior Warrants, and Champion titles in Ireland and Luxembourg.

Sarah is on the B List to judge both Rottweilers and French Bulldogs and has served on various Club Committees.

MRS ANGELA POWER (WALLBECK)

Angela, from Waterford, is a well known exhibitor and judge in Ireland, and has exhibited various breeds over many groups including, Pugs, Pekingese, Pomeranians, West Highland White Terriers, and Dalmatians. Angela serves on the Committee of Deise Canine Club.

Angela judges breeds in all groups, along with the Groups and has judged Best In Show.

MISS ELAINE BULTER (BALLY SAX)

Elaine is best known for exhibiting Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, along with her parents from their successful Waterford-based Kennel. They have won many titles including UK and Irish Champions.

Elaine had her first judging appointment in 1998 and her judging has seen her judge across Ireland, where she has judged BIS Open Show level, awarded Green Stars across groups 2 & 3, and also judged Group 3. Elaine has also judged in Sweden.

Elaine is also a committee member of Deise Canine Club.

MS CATHERINE KELLY (RISLEY)
